Final Clemson Photo Shoot Coming Up

The last of four days of photography in Clemson has been scheduled for Friday, July 3, 2009. Days of photography in fall, winter, and spring have been completed.

This is the last full day to focus on what Clemson people do. As people go about their activities on July 3, we hope they take a camera along. We would like to see photographs depicting recreation, outdoor activities, business or service activities, and Clemson celebrating our national holiday. This last date is especially suitable for photos displaying patriotic themes, and we are especially interested in photos of military personnel away from home communicating with their families.
